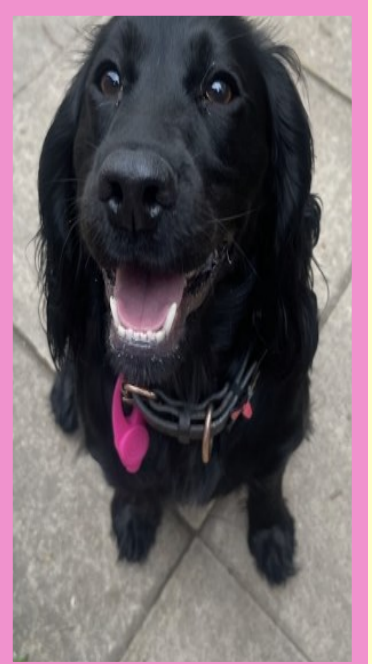

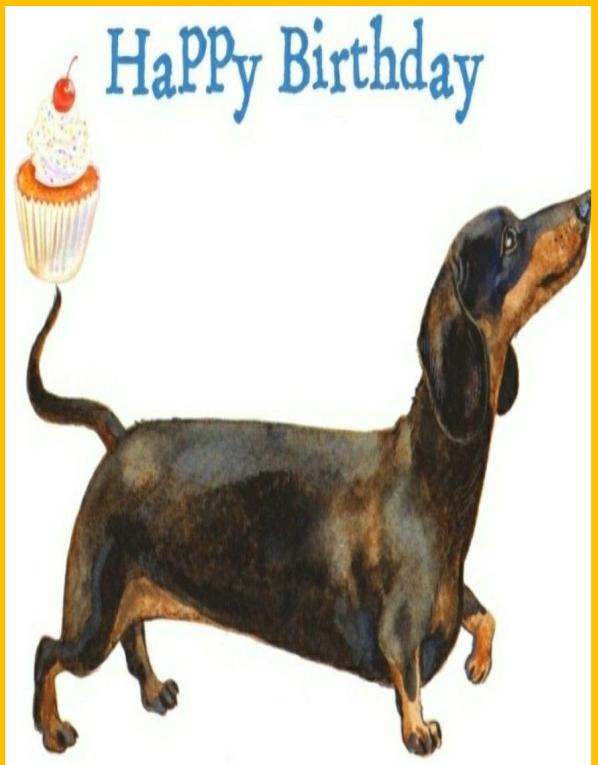

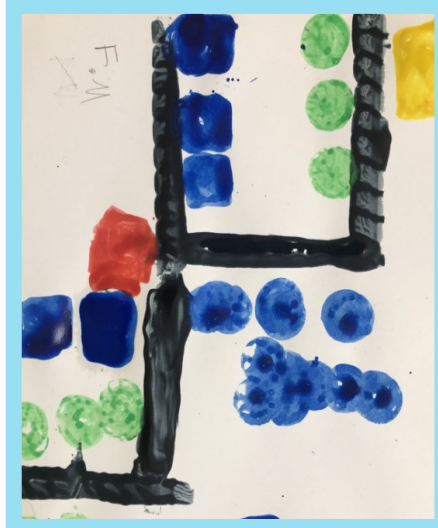

# celebrating our week



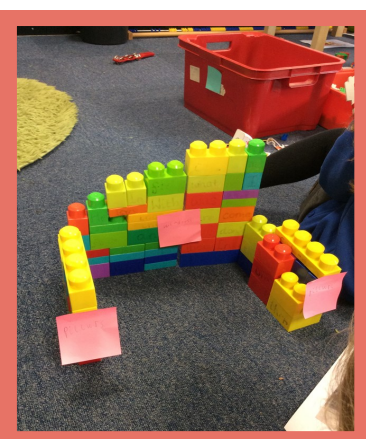
Year 4 have been experimenting with body percussion during their music sessions. They had lots of fun and laughter creating pieces of music.

The children have settled in very well at Nursery and are enjoying exploring and playing in the different areas our role play house is very popular!



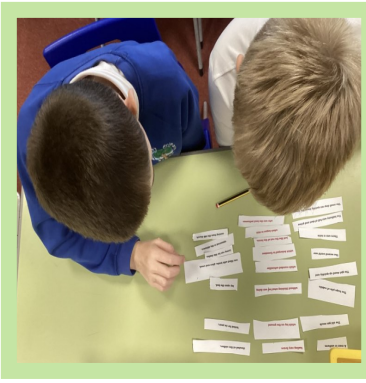
In Geography, Year 1 used construction materials to build famous landmarks in Coventry. The children then the features of these and labelled them.
