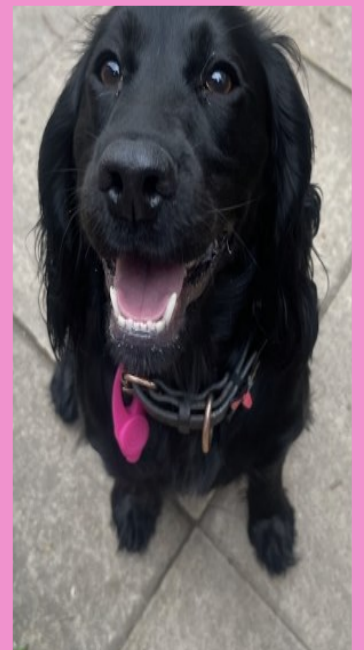

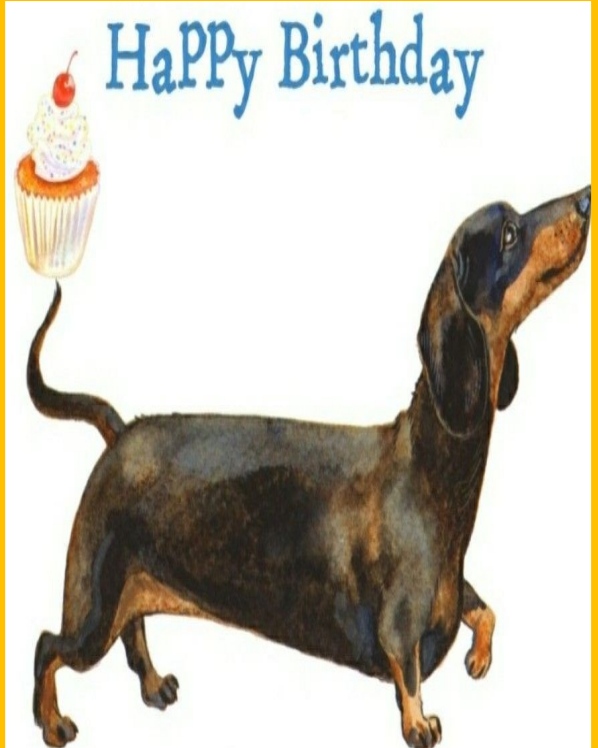

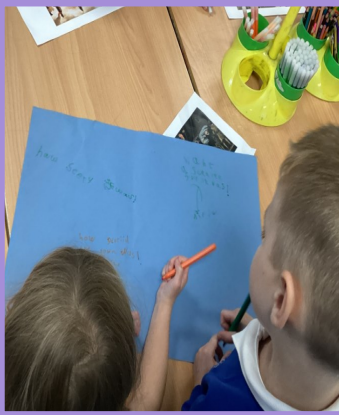
# celebrating our week
