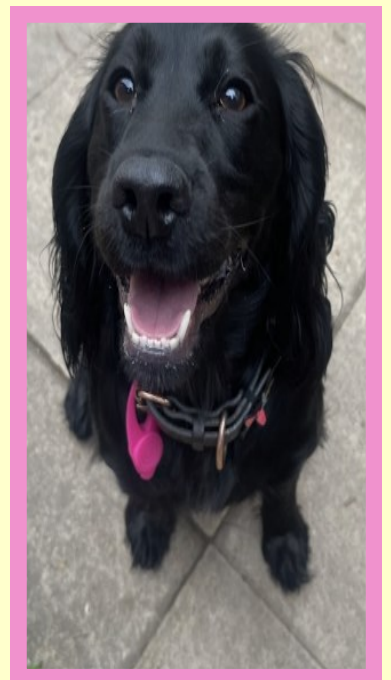

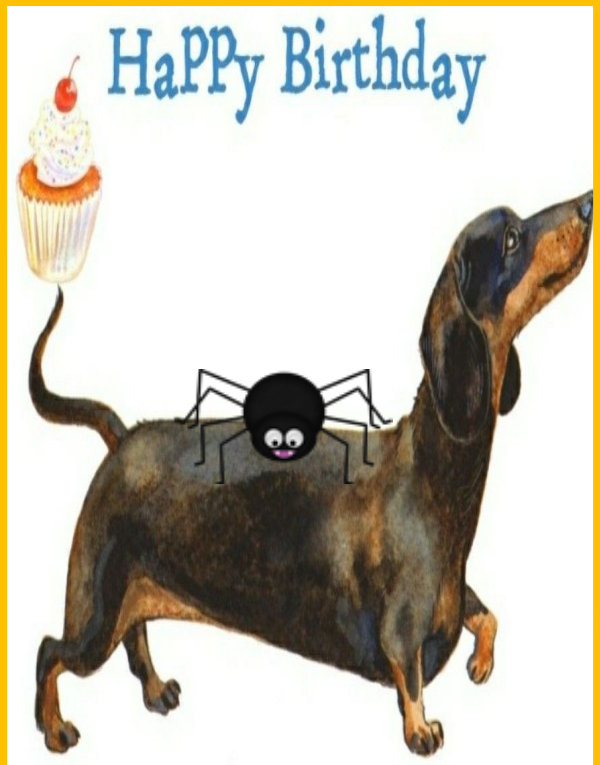

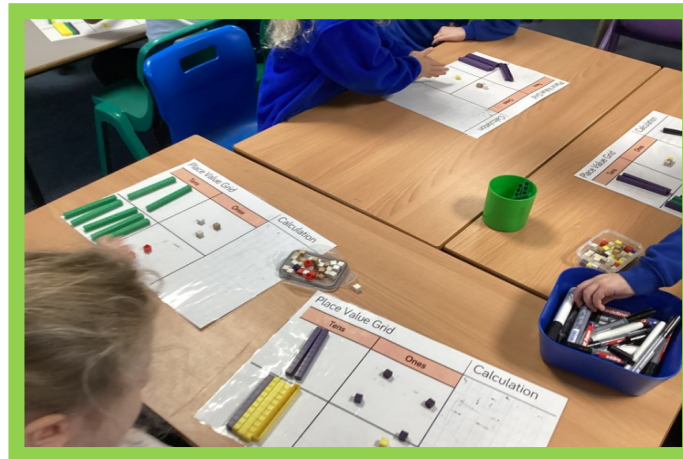

This week Year 2 have been learning about adding two-digit numbers in maths. We used base 10's and place value charts to help us with our learning.



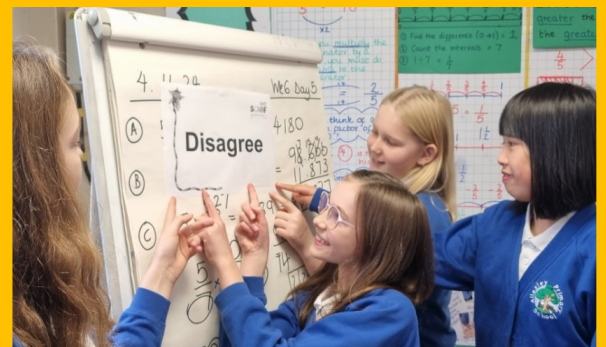

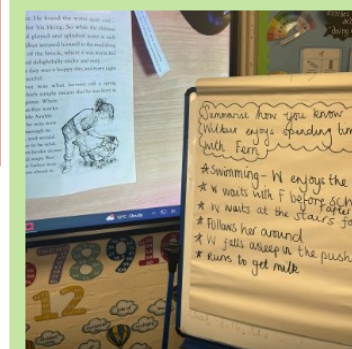
This week in Year 1 we had Julia back for our yoga sessions. The children enjoyed remembering their animal poses "moose", "otter" and "elephant".
