




<u>Reception Nativity Change to ticket allocation</u>-All children will be allocated 4 tickets per family, 2 for each day to use as you wish.








This week in **Year 1** we had Julia back for our yoga sessions. The children enjoyed remembering their animal poses "moose", "otter" and "elephant".


This week, **Year 3** enjoyed getting messy whilst making papyrus paper.
