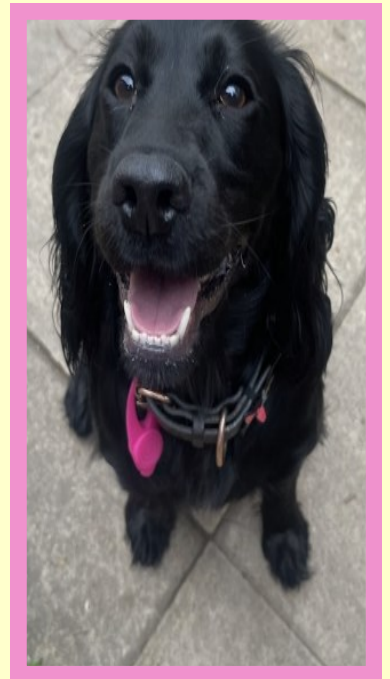

# Celebrating our week



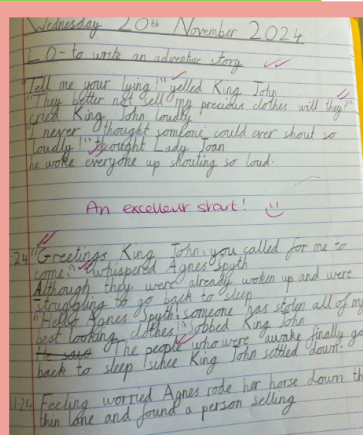
The **Reception** children have been reading and investigating activities to do with Stickman - Focusing on Phonics, Physical development and turn taking.



**Year 1** have been working exceptionally hard to create their own moving story scenes using sliders.



This week, **Year 3** enjoyed learning about the human digestive system. They looked at the journey food makes through the body.



**Year 4** are drafting their adventure stories based on Thomas Snoop Tudor Spy. We've made an excellent start!



In **Year 2** we have been learning about algorithms in computing. We came up with a real-life version of our scratch dinosaur animation.



In maths this week, **Year 6** have been exploring units of measure. We used our rulers to measure ourselves in feet and converted the remaining cm into inches! Lots of great maths being used.



In **Nursery** we loved playing in the snow this week, we've also rescued the arctic animals from being stuck in the ice because of the cold weather.

We investigated forces in **Year 5** this week. We used pendulums of different lengths to see the effect of friction, and discovered that the pendulum is pulled down by gravity and it slows down and stops due to friction.
