



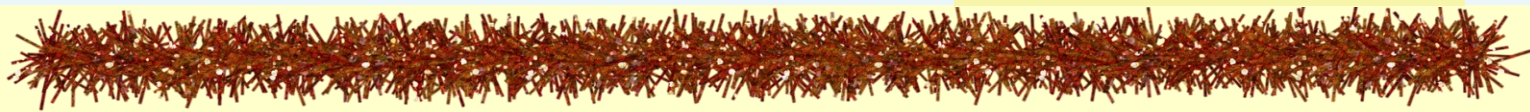

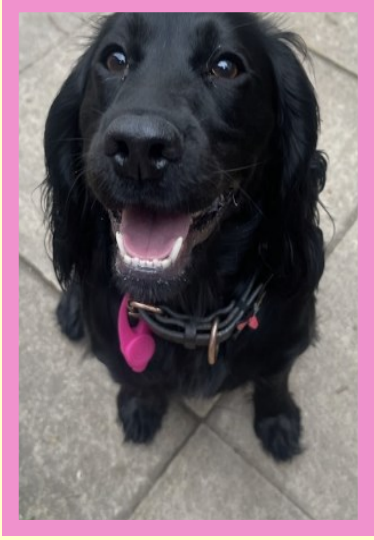

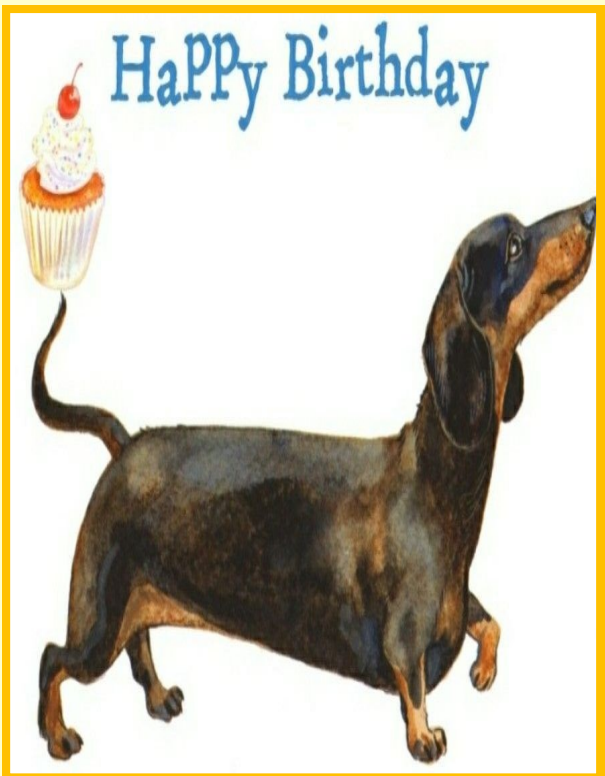

The **Reception** children have had a special visitor from the north pole come to see us this week, he has been up to a lot of mischief!



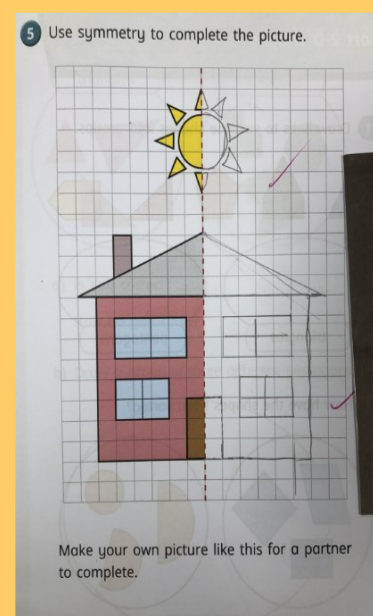
This week **year 1** have been measuring rainfall using their rain gauges. They worked together to measure the amount of rain Allesley had over two weeks.
