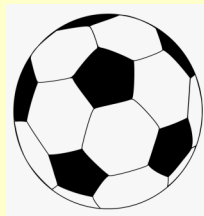

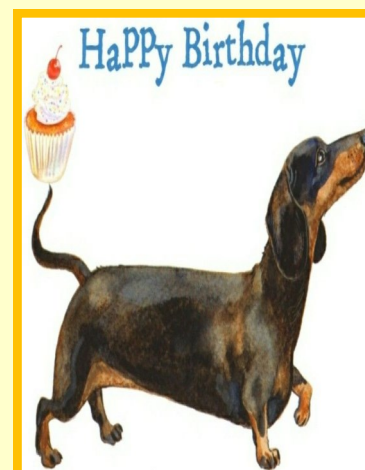

This week Year 2 role-played stories from the Torah in R.E.



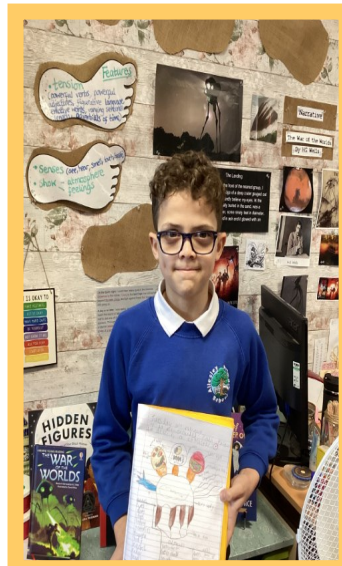
In science Year 1 have been testing materials to see if they sink or float. We put our learning to the test by making boats for our toys to cross the ocean.
